WHAT WE DO.

FACILITIES

Idaho BMX operates two permanent outdoor tracks located in the Boise area with the potential for an indoor, seasonal temporary track during the winter months.

COMMUNITY

Located in public parks our facilities are open to the public. Our program offers availability to all ages and skill levels, we also have rental bikes and helmets available on request.

PRACTICES

Weekly open practices at both tracks for riders with, or without a USA/BMX sanction membership.

RACING

Weekly races at each track for local single point races, annual state and regional qualifying events each season. Free first race for all new members to the sport, we don't turn anyone away!

CLINICS

Skills clinics for beginning to advanced riders are offered at each track throughout the season and often coached by nationally ranked or professional BMX riders.

MISSION



VISION





Our program was able to draw a wide variety of professional riders from across the nation including Corbin Sharrah (left, in his awesome American flag racing gear) who is a two time U.S. Olympic medalist.

As our program grows, bringing opportunities home to our riders is important. We were able to host Olivia Armstrong, a USA/BMX Women's Pro rider who consistently holds a top ten place nationally. She coached two full clinics for our local riders at our Caldwell track and provided amazing one-on-one attention skills coaching.
